SAFEGUARDING GUIDELINES -V1 – March 2022

- Any volunteer under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult. It is the responsibility of the accompanying adult to supervise the under 18
- Any volunteer who is identified as an adult at risk should be accompanied by a responsible adult where this is required. It is the responsibility of the accompanying adult to supervise the adult at risk
- Please ensure that you share these guidelines (and other volunteer information) with anyone under your supervision in the most appropriate manner

- Always ensure that another responsible adult is in sight, if you are with any children or adults at risk as part of your volunteer role (and not acting as the responsible adult caring for that individual)

- In case of emergency one to one care can be given, but endeavour to have another appropriate adult present and ideally the carer

- Any found children (and adults at risk) should be brought to the main meeting point for the event/venue and the parent/carer sought by the most appropriate manner. If required the event incident manager to be contacted

- If you have any concerns about anyone's behaviour or there is an issue please contact one of the incident managers or bring this to the attention of a committee member
