



How to make... A Mask

Instructions:

Step 1:

If you already have a plastic mask then you can skip this step.

If you want to make a card mask, carefully cut out a mask shape from card including holes for eyes and head to the next step.

If you want to make a Papier-mâché mask, cut up newspaper into thin strips. Prepare a bowl with PVA glue and water mixed together and blow up your balloon. Dip a strip of newspaper into the glue mixture and then lay it on the balloon. Keep adding more and more strips until half the balloon is covered. Then wait for it to dry.

Step 2:

Using paints make a nice design on it. You can paint anything you like from patterns to specific drawings. You could even add more raised textures using Papier-mâché like step 1 for more dramatic looking masks.

Step 3:
